

A 2015 home invasion took the life of expectant mom Amanda Blackburn, a pastor's wife. Now Davey Blackburn shares the rest of the story – his journey from hate and heartbreak to forgiveness and purpose.

Nashville, TN (April 29, 2024) – Can a glimmer of faith or hope survive a living nightmare? How does a person ever move forward after trauma, tragedy, and devastating heartbreak? Is it possible to believe that nothing is wasted as we endure unimaginable loss?

After the 2015 murder of his beloved wife Amanda and their unborn daughter, Davey Blackburn found himself wrestling with these questions as he lived his worst nightmare. As a high-profile criminal case unfolded over several years, Davey began the seemingly impossible task of finding the strength to restore his shattered soul and the broken pieces of his life. Now that the court cases are done and the appeals from Amanda's murderer have concluded, Davey Blackburn recounts the worst day of his life and throws a lifeline of hope to all who struggle under the weight of grief.

In his heartbreaking yet inspiring new book, Nothing is Wasted: A True Story of Hope, Forgiveness, and Finding Purpose in Pain (Forefront Books, July 30, 2024), national speaker, podcaster, nonprofit leader, and former pastor Davey Blackburn offers a raw

account of the tragedy that forever changed his life. Davey unpacks how he began facing his pain head-on and eventually discovered a new purpose and hope despite devastating circumstances.

"Pain and suffering are inseparable and inescapable parts of life," **Davey** writes in **Nothing is Wasted**. "But you get to decide what you're going to do with your story. Will you waste it? Will you let yourself get stuck, paralyzed, floundering in hopelessness, or self-pity, or despair? He assures readers that in their greatest loss or darkest tragedy, there is a path that leads to redemption, healing, hope, and faith. In that place, it's possible to begin to see that nothing has been wasted.

Today **Davey Blackburn** spends his time encouraging people around the world to find purpose in their pain. He is the founder of Nothing is Wasted Ministries, a sought-after speaker, and the host of the *Nothing is Wasted Podcast* which has seen more than 3 million downloads since 2018.

Interview Questions

- Davey, your young family experienced unimaginable tragedy in November 2015, when your home was invaded and your pregnant wife Amanda was murdered. How did you manage to survive the first few days, weeks, and months after her death? Who helped you and Weston (your son was just 18 months old) make it through that initial season of grief?
- Your new memoir is entitled **Nothing is Wasted**. How does that title reflect the seven years you shared with your wife Amanda and the almost nine years since her death?
- How did the media coverage of the criminal investigation and the years-long court cases affect your grief and your healing process?
- You write that healing happens when we slow down and let time do its work. What did this look like for you, and why is it difficult to heal slowly?
- You and Amanda moved to Indianapolis to plant a new church where you were the pastor. How did your relationship with God change after losing Amanda? Did this loss change how you pastored people in pain?
- How did you handle the guilt you felt after Amanda's death, and how did you keep it from completely paralyzing you?
- You wondered why God allowed this to happen since you and Amanda simply wanted to serve Him with your lives. How do you manage the tension of realizing you may never know why God allowed this tragedy?
- You share that you struggled with deep hatred at one point, and yet you were eventually able to forgive the men convicted of Amanda's death. Tell us about your journey to forgiveness.
- After Amanda's passing, what sparked your desire to help kids and teenagers in inner-city Indianapolis?
- People may think of redemption as life returning to what it was before a bad thing happened. But that wasn't possible for you. What did your road to redemption look like?
- You write that you and your current wife Kristi are living a beautiful story of redemption and healing, forgiveness and hope. How did God bring the two of you together? What has it been like to blend your two families?
- How would you encourage people who are walking through a tragedy, transition, or trial today?
