- Jefferson, many of us remember your spoken word video, “Why I Hate Religion But Love Jesus,” which went viral on YouTube a couple years ago. What’s happened in your life since then?
 - Let’s talk about the subtitle of your new book: *Why Christianity Is About so Much More than Going to Heaven When You Die*
 - Tell us how study of the first-century world of Jesus has changed your reading of the Gospels. Has it added more color to your imagination of Jesus’ life?
 - You open your new book by saying “Christianity is a bounced check to your generation.” What do you mean by that? How can we make better promises to the next generation?
 - It seems many Christians focus on sin management, but you write that our focus should be on how God is restoring all things. How would that look in everyday life?
 - You also spend a chapter of this new book discussing Sabbath and rest. How do we practice (or not practice) rest differently than God intended?
 - I love the story you tell about a friend from elementary school, Big Mike. How does Big Mike remind you of your true identity in Christ?
 - You have some heavy things to say about loving our enemies and what it means to live as Kingdom people. How do Christians live that out here in America – or in Syria?
 - All of us are wounded at times, as humans and followers of Christ. Why do you say we should celebrate our scars?
 - You ask this question in your book: “Would we rather have Jesus give us all the answers, or would we rather sit at the table with him?” Tell us how you came to ask that question.
 - Seems like you and your wife Alyssa are asked lots of questions about dating and marriage. What’s the best piece of advice you have for dating?
 - Jefferson, we know you love to connect online with readers of your books. How can they reach out to you after reading *It's Not What You Think*?
