 - How are Islam and Christianity similar? And why is that important to acknowledge?
 - Do Muslims and Christians worship the same God?
 - What do you find to be the biggest stumbling block for Muslims considering Christianity?
 - How can both Jesus and Muhammad claim to be god? Why is it important to compare their claimed deity?
 - How does the Muslim term *Sharia*, loosely translated as “how to live,” compare to the Christian term *The Gospel*?
 - How does individual responsibility play into the differences between Islam and Christianity?
 - Why is the concept of the Trinity important to both Christians and Muslims?
 - How does the Muslim view of the Quran compare to how Christians view the Bible?
 - Aren't the Crusades worse than any violence in Muslim history?
 - Shouldn't all Christians be pacifists? What about Holy Wars and terrorism?
 - Can we honestly know if Christianity or Islam is true?
 - What do you hope a reader will do after reading *No God But One—Allah or Jesus?*
