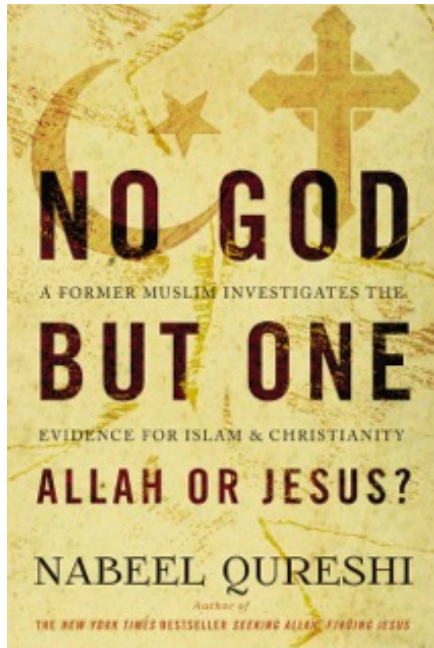
New Book from Award-Winning Author Nabeel Qureshi

No God but One: Allah or Jesus?

Former Muslim & Bestselling Author Investigates the Evidence for Islam & Christianity

Grand Rapids, MI—On September 11, 2001, Nabeel Qureshi was called home from college by his devout father,

who said it was dangerous to be a faithful Muslim in the US in the aftermath of the terrorist attacks. Muslim violence against Americans didn't square with the religion Nabeel had been faithfully taught by his parents from birth – Qureshi adamantly believed Islam to be a religion of peace.



When a college friend began talking with him about Christianity, Qureshi saw the new friendship as an opportunity to prove the God of Islam was correct over the God of Christianity. Yet when he closely examined his faith, Qureshi found himself at a crossroads as he discovered the distinctions between Islam and Christianity.

Nabeel Qureshi's 2014 memoir *Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus* described his heart journey from Islam to Christianity and became a *New York Times* bestseller. This year he recounts his intellectual and theological journey in the follow-up book entitled *No God but One: Allah or Jesus?: A Former Muslim Investigates the Evidence for Islam and Christianity* (Zondervan, August 30, 2016). Qureshi details how an analysis of the history and theology of the world's two largest, most popular religions reveal stark differences between Islam and Christianity.

In *No God but One: Allah or Jesus?* Qureshi unveils a fundamental, enduring conflict between Islam and Christianity. He writes to answer three major questions: 1) What are the differences between Islam and Christianity? 2) Can we be confident that either Christianity or Islam is true? 3) Is it worth sacrificing everything for the truth?

Qureshi directly addresses controversial topics such as:

- Can Allah and Jesus Both Be God?
- Is the Idea of God as a Trinity Problematic?
- How Does the Quran Compare to the Bible?
- Did the Council of Nicaea Randomly Decide the Biblical Canon?
- What Is the Difference between Jihad and the Crusades?
- If Jesus Is God How Did He Die on a Cross? Who Was Ruling the Universe when He Was Dead?

Qureshi does not take on this debate lightly, knowing the heavy cost of conversion: "For me, it's been a decade since I made the decision to leave Islam, and the fallout of my decision haunts me every day. I knew it would, well

before I ever converted, but I also knew that I was sure. I was sure that Islam and Christianity are not just two paths that lead to the same God, but two very different paths that lead very different ways.”

Qureshi will be taking a break from his doctoral studies at Oxford University to promote ***No God but One: Allah or Jesus?*** in the United States this fall. He has speaking events scheduled for Washington, DC, New York City, Chicago, Houston, as well as campus events at Auburn University, the University of Arkansas, Texas A&M, and more.

Qureshi has dreamed of writing this new book for at least a decade: “In my speaking around the world, I have met thousands of people who desperately seek God and are caught between the polemics of Islam and Christianity. I do not claim to be unbiased, but I have been on both sides of this debate, and I know how taxing it can be to try to wade through all the arguments.”

About Nabeel Qureshi: Qureshi is the author of *The New York Times* bestselling and award-winning memoir *Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus* (2015) and *Answering Jihad: A Better Way Forward* (March 2016). Qureshi has lectured at more than 100 universities, including Oxford, Rice, Columbia, Dartmouth, Cornell, Johns Hopkins, and the University of Hong Kong. He has been featured in countless media outlets including *The Hugh Hewitt Show*, Fox News, *Fox & Friends*, *Christianity Today*, and *USA Today*. In addition to his two master’s degrees, Qureshi earned a medical doctorate (MD) from Eastern Virginia Medical School and is completing a PhD at Oxford University.
